Setting Up VPN Access For Windows 10

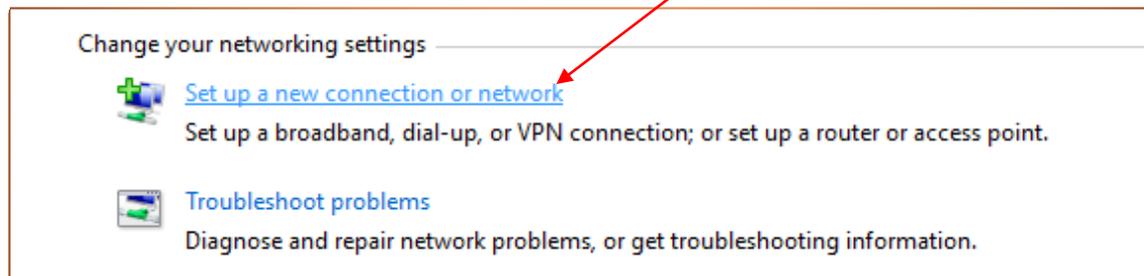
- The following steps will guide you through setting up your Windows 10 VPN Network to connect to your Netgear Firewall



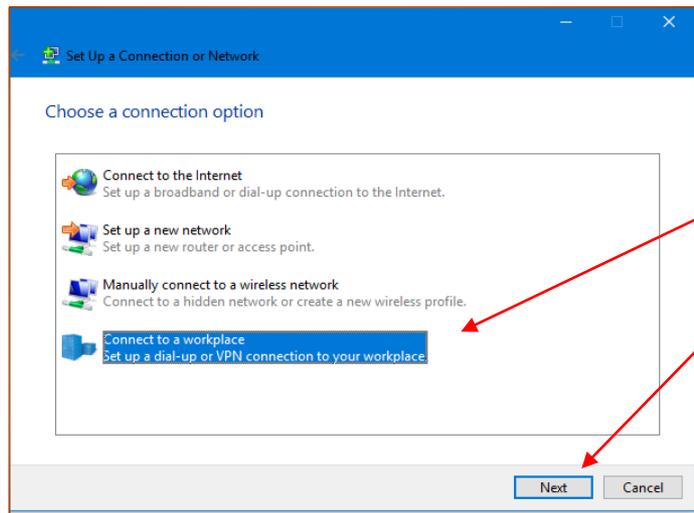
Access Your Windows Control Panel



1. Open your windows “Control Panel”
2. Select “Network and Sharing Center”
3. Next select “Setup a new connection or network”

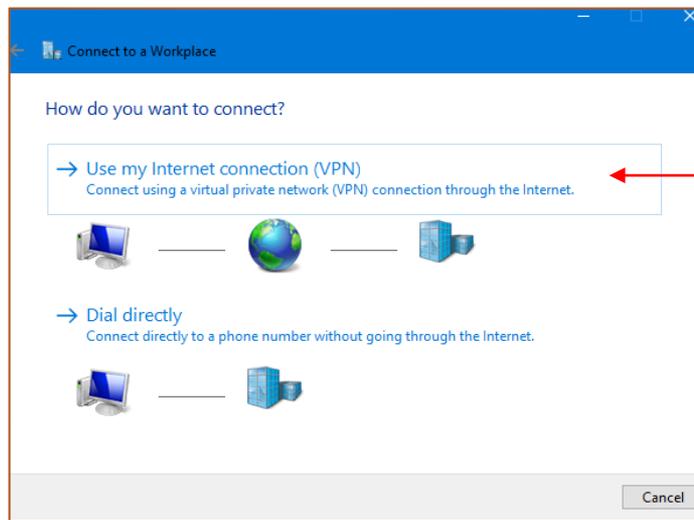


Set up a Connection or Network

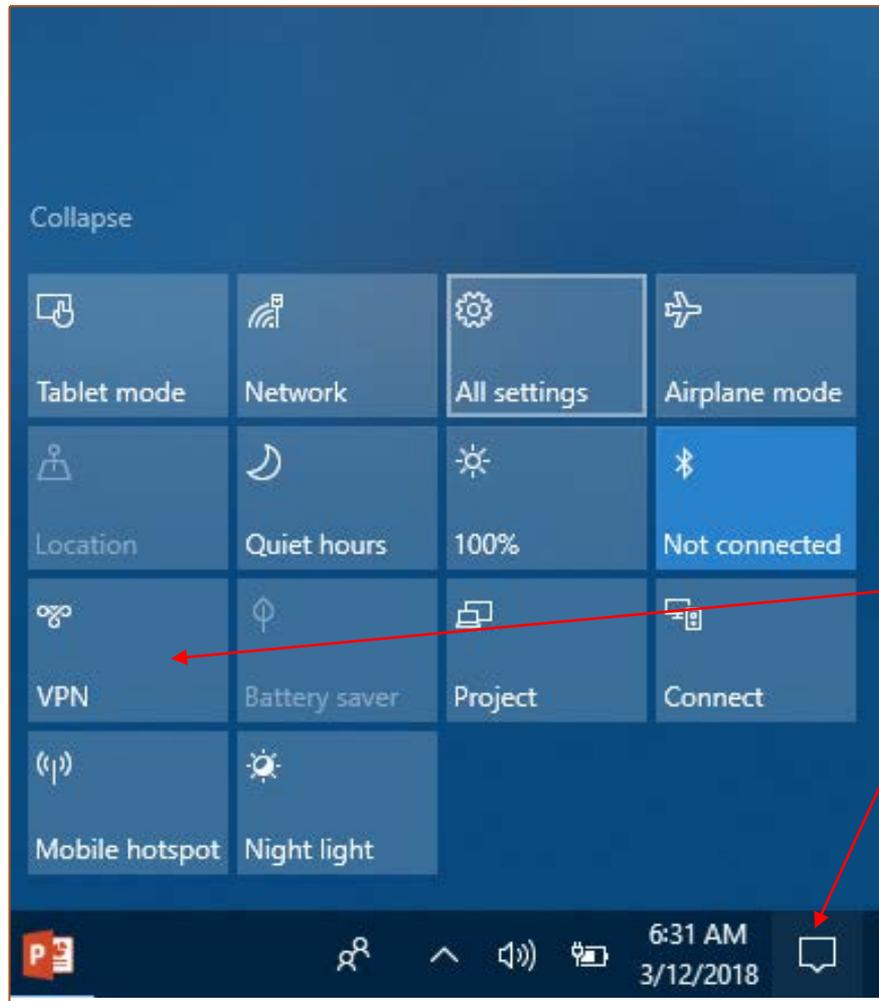

5. Click “Save”

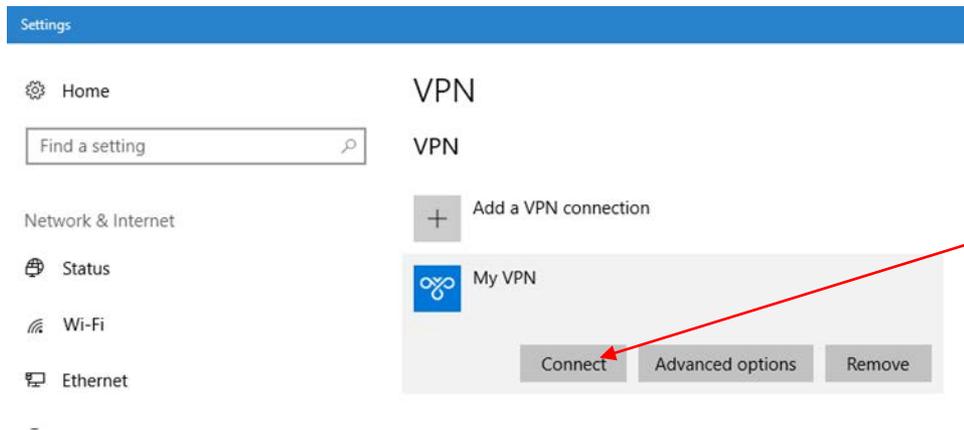
